Metro South and South Shore Chambers to Form Joint Task Force to Explore Possible Affiliation

What is Pay-Per-Click (PPC) and How Does it Work?











PPC is a type of internet marketing which involves advertisers paying a fee each time one of their ads is clicked. Simply, you only pay for advertising if your ad is actually clicked on. It's essentially a method of 'buying' visits to your site, in addition to driving website visits organically. As always, your feedback and input are welcome and encouraged.

What is PPC and How it Works

Pay-per-click (PPC) is an internet advertising model where advertisers pay a fee each time someone clicks on their ad. Let's delve into the basics:

Definition: In PPC, you pay for targeted visits to your website, landing page, or app. When executed correctly, the cost per click is outweighed by the value of the click.

Ad Formats: PPC ads come in various for-mats, including text, images, videos, or a combination. They can appear on search engines, websites, social media platforms, and more.

Search Engine Advertising: One of the most popular forms of PPC is search engine advertising (also known as paid search or Search Engine Marketing). Advertisers bid on relevant keyword phrases related to their business offerings. When users search for those keywords, the ads appear in the sponsored links section of the search engine results page (SERP).

How It Works:

- · Campaign Setup: Choose your campaign type based on your objective.
- **Settings and Targeting:** Refine settings such as audiences, devices, locations, and schedules.
- **Budget and Bidding:** Specify your budget and bidding strategy.
- · Ad Creation: Build your ad, considering factors like ad copy, visuals, and landing page.
- Algorithmic Placement: Once the ad goes live, its placement, timing, and cost per click are determined algorithmically based on your parameters and ad quality.

Google Ads: Google Ads is the most popular PPC advertising system globally. It allows you to create relevant and effective campaigns that reach your target audience while optimizing your budget. Remember, successful PPC involves creating relevant, trustworthy campaigns to maximize profits. If you're already using Google Ads, consider checking your performance with the free Google Ads Performance Grader.




